## **ORDER of REVOCATION effective 08/30/2015**

You submitted to a chemical test of your blood or breath which revealed an alcohol content of 0.245 within two hours of driving. This is above the legal limit; your privilege to drive in Colorado is hereby revoked for a period of nine months, C.R.S. 42-2-126. However, if you are 21 years of age or older, you may be eligible to reinstate early with ignition interlock restricted driving privileges after one month under revocation, C.R.S. 42-2-132.5.

IF YOU DISAGREE WITH THIS ORDER, THE DEPARTMENT MUST RECEIVE YOUR WRITTEN REQUEST FOR A HEARING ON OR BEFORE 08/29/2015 . OTHERWISE, YOU WAIVE YOUR RIGHT TO A HEARING AND THIS ORDER IS FINAL. You may make your request for a hearing at any Driver License office. If you surrender a valid license either prior to or at the time of your request, the Department will delay the effectiveness of this order and issue a driving permit valid until the date of your hearing. If you want the officer present at the hearing, you may indicate it in your written request, or you may subpoena the officer at least five calendar days prior to the hearing date. Once you receive notice of the date and time of your hearing, you may contact the Hearings Division at (303) 205-5606 to arrange issuance of any subpoenas. If you reinstate with interlock restricted driving privileges prior to the hearing, you waive your right to proceed with the hearing on the merits, C.R.S. 42-2-132.

This order remains in effect until 05/29/2016 and until you do the following:

- 1) Pay the reinstatement fee; 2) File an SR22 from your insurance company;
- 3) Submit an alcohol Certification. If your blood or breath alcohol content was 0.15 or greater, you will also have to: 4) Enroll in Level II alcohol education and therapy; and, 5) Have an ignition interlock device for a period of at least two years following reinstatement. After reinstatement it remains unlawful for you to drive until you apply for and receive a new license.
